We hope the start to your spring has been warm, welcome, and rewarding! We've had quite an eventful couple weeks here at Redress, and are super excited to tell you about it. Here goes!

A small win, on the way to a big win, in Milwaukee!

On March 6th, Milwaukee Senior Campaign Organizer Dynasty Ceasar turned out dozens of folks to the County Board of Supervisors' Health Equity, Human Needs & Strategic Planning Committee hearing, to support the creation of an official Housing Committee. Concerned residents, not politicians, will make up the majority of Committee members, which will be authorized to craft solutions we need in the affordable housing crisis.

After the Health Equity voted unanimously to advance the resolution creating the Housing Committee, we expect the resolution to pass at the March 21st County Board meeting - that's today! Unfortunately, no public comments are accepted at that meeting, but we welcome you to watch in person or online.

But our work is far from over.

We still need to make sure the Housing Committee passes at the full County Board Meeting, and we need to make sure we are well-represented when it does. If you live in Milwaukee, now is your chance to make your voice heard!

Two BIG votes in Denver!

Redress' Denver Senior Campaign Organizer, Kevin Patterson, has been working with Redress neighbors to fight hard in support of two bills currently in the state legislature.

HB 24-1098, which passed after the State House Committee vote, would create "for cause" eviction protections and require landlords to have a valid reason before removing families from their homes. The next step for this bill is a vote in the full House. We aren't exactly sure when that is going to happen yet, but if you are in Colorado, it's time to take action!

The second bill we've been organizing in support of is HB24-1337, which would level the playing field for homeowners and cap HOA legal fees and give homeowners the right to redemption after a foreclosure sale. This means that after a foreclosure, homeowners will have 180 days to repurchase their homes!

This bill comes after working with victims of HOAs' punitive enforcement efforts, such as Monica Villela and her family. Monica and her family were foreclosed upon, even though they stayed current on their mortgage, because of minor HOA infractions like garbage bins being left on the curb for too long, which ended up costing them \$8,000 in legal fees.

HB24-1337 would rein in this kind of behavior from HOAs, and if you are in Colorado, we need you to voice your support!
