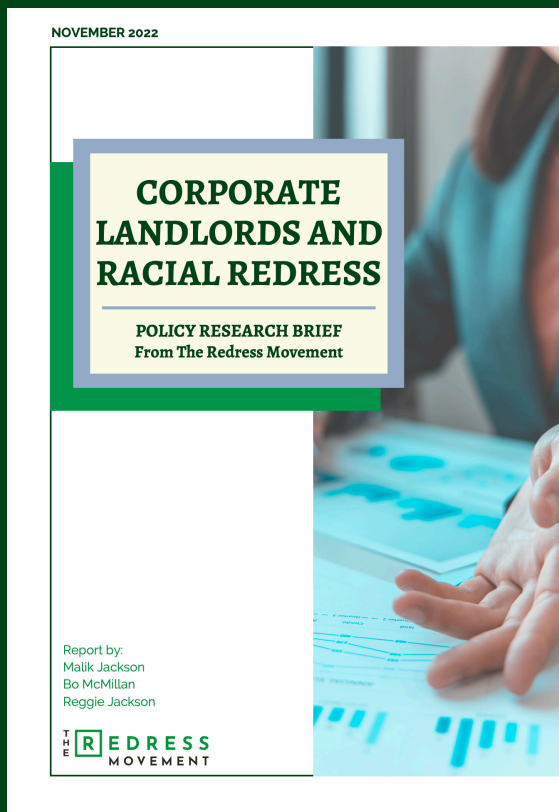
❄️ **Hey there, Neighbor!** ❄️

It talks about how Corporate Landlords drive up housing prices by eliminating affordable housing supply, charge tenants a litany of atypical fees, and evict residents at higher rates than smaller, mom-and-pop landlords. It highlights a number of potential interventions to curb corporate landlord power through different levels of housing policy and grassroots organization, and focuses on the Corporate Landlord activity in Charlotte, NC.

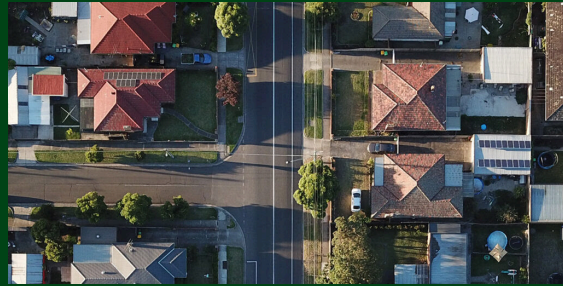
